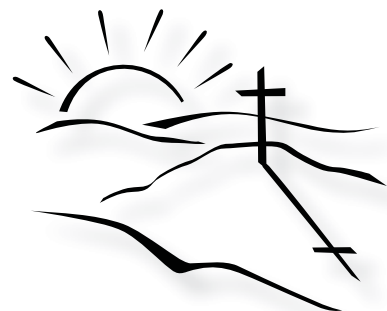
RETREAT

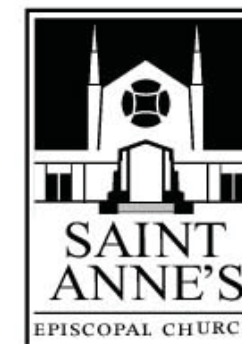
